The names shown on the attached list are only of those members that are active in the LSA. The Membership Status Column reflects those members that are Current in their 2008 Dues. If the year listed after your name is different than 2008, that signifies the last year we have a record of your dues payment. Won't you please take a moment, and fill in the attached Membership Form to become current in your dues.

Please be advised, we retain the names of ALL Members, in our Active and Non-Active Roster Logs.

Note; "Due to privacy concerns". These lists are restricted, and we cannot print member's contact information. Contact with any one on these lists may be made only via the Membership Director. I will advise them of your interest, and arrange for them to contact you. If you wish NOT to be contacted, just let me know, and I will be happy to handle.

Due to some feedback from our last published lists, where our 1st column listed our Members Names Alphabetically. Some members indicated it was difficult to sort through the list to find their ships hull #, name, and years served aboard. We listened, and have changed the format for this year. Starting with column # 1; we are listing the Lightships by Hull #, in ascending order, low Hull # 1st. We thought about sorting by Lightship Station name. However, many different Lightships may have served on the same Lightship Station. Once on that station, they assumed that station's name, and a good many had different Hull #'s. One example might be Nantucket Station... some of our active LSA Members served on this station aboard the 112/534, 196, 612, and 613.

Sorting by Hull #; an example given might be Hull # 613... she served as Ambrose, Relief (MA), Nantucket II. We found sorting by Hull # the best route to go in order to simplify your search.

Additionally, before each grouping. We have listed the year each ship was built, year retired, and a <u>very brief</u> subsequent disposition, status, and information we have available on her.

We do hope you find this list helpful, and can locate some old shipmates. For your convenience, we have posted a Contact Request Form on the back of this edition.

Our upcoming "Reunion in HYANNIS, MA on October 16th. thru the 18th". Would be a great opportunity to get re-united with these old shipmates.
